This year we will be offering a half-day seminar, golf tournament and wrap up dinner banquet.

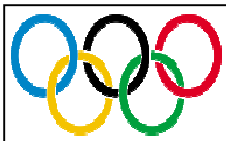
Registration and a welcome reception will be held at 6 pm at the Harrison Hot Springs Resort & Spa on Thursday June 24th.
